

Main Site Treatment 7: Native Succession

Growing Season: 2012

---

- A. Burn all plots in the early spring.
- B. Chisel plow and soil finish the micro-plot area each spring. Try to time the tillage in the micro-plot area with the tillage of treatment 1 tillage. Try to have the micro-plot area of treatment 7 tilled within the same week that tillage in treatment 1 is completed. In a winter wheat years till the plots in late April or early May. The micro-plot area in treatment 7 is an annually disturbed (20 meters X 20 meters) area on the north end of each replication. Notify Carol Baker when tillage operations have been completed.
- C. No mowing or tillage within any treatment 7 plot at any time, except for the micro-plot area.

This is a working protocol used for planning purposes. Due to potential changes in chemicals, fertilizer, varieties planted, planting dates etc... please refer to the agronomic field log for actual field operations that take place during 2012.
