PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT: Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, and waterproof gloves when handling treated seed. Workers may choose to wear a dust mask.

STORAGE: Store away from food and feedstuffs. DO NOT allow children, pets, or livestock to have access to treated seed.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water bodies when disposing of planting equipment washwaters. Dispose of seed packaging or containers in accordance with local requirements. Do not re-use bags from treated seed to handle food or feed products. Dispose of all excess treated seed. Left over treated seed may be doublesown around the headland or buried away from water sources in accordance with local requirements. Excess seed may be used for ethanol production only if (1) by-products are not used for livestock feed and (2) no measurable residues of pesticide remain in the ethanol by-products that are used in agronomic practice.

REPLANTING: In the event of crop failure or harvest of a crop grown from Warden® Cereals II treated seed, the field may be replanted immediately to canola, soybean, and cereal grains (barley, oat, yee, triticale, and wheat). All other crops may not be planted until 30 days after planting treated seeds.

The suaximum numb of applications per season is 2.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Treated seeds exposed on soil surface may be hazardous to wildlife. Cover or collect treated seeds spulled during loading.

Groundwater Advisory: Mefenoxam is known to leach through soil into groundwater under certain conditions as result of agricultural use. Use of this chemical in areas where soils are permeable, particularly where the water table is shallow, may result in ground water contamination.
